RULES FOR APPLICATION

1. What youth organization are you affiliated with, Rainbow, Jobs or Demolay? How many years have you been a member and what offices have you held? **You will need the signature of a mother advisor, bethel guardian or dad advisor.**
2. High School Seniors may apply. Also, first, second and third year college students may apply. (Full time students only.)
3. Applications must be completely filled out. Typewritten applications and statements are preferred over handwritten submissions. Application must be signed.
4. Include First Semester transcript of grades. College students include most recent semester grades. Applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 system.
5. The applicant shall prepare an essay of more than 250 words and less than 300 words setting forth their vocational or professional goal. It should relate how past, present and future activities make the accomplishment of this goal possible. The additional criteria by which the applications will be judged are scholarship, leadership in school and non-school related activities (i.e. church, scouts and youth organizations.)
6. Two but not more than three letters of recommendation are required. The letters must be signed and dated by the author and must cover the applicants ability, work habits, leadership, personality and integrity. (Family and relatives are non-applicable.)
7. A Michigander check for the amount of the scholarship will be given to the recipient upon receipt of verification of enrollment.
8. Applications **MUST** BE POSTMARKED by June 1, 2009.
